Mango orders will be delivered next week (week 9). A day and time are yet to be confirmed with Bowen's Mangoes.

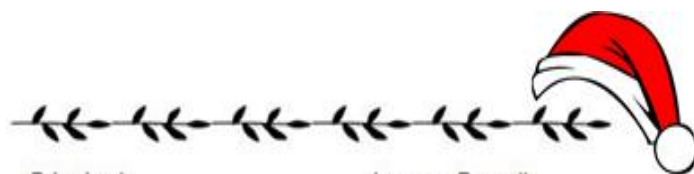
