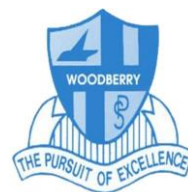

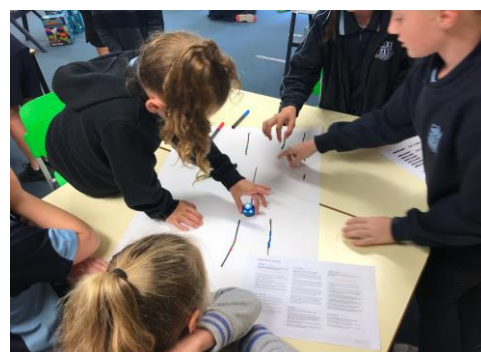
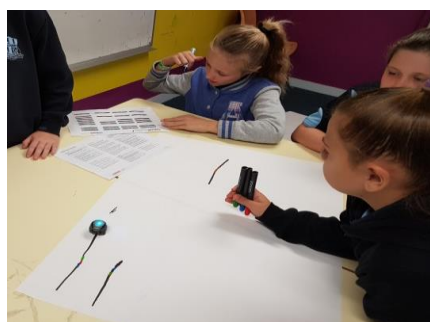


Peek at our week

YEAR 6 POLO SHIRTS

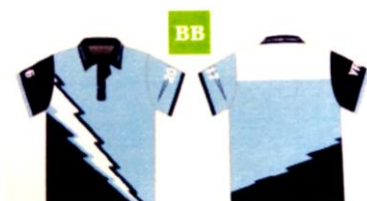
It is that time of year again to order our Year 6 Polo shirts for 2018!


