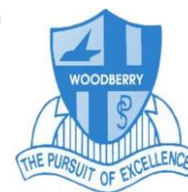

NAIDOC Assembly, BBQ and NAIDOC Cup POSTPONED TO TERM 3.

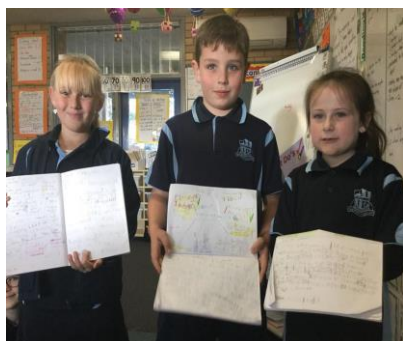
Poetry, Rap writing and Colouring Competitions are due **this FRIDAY 6th JULY.**
