IMMUNISATION UPDATE REMINDER

Last term some parent/carers received a letter asking for an **updated immunisation record** for their child. The school also needs to know if a child has never been immunised as this needs to be noted in the school records.

Please note that if a child **is not immunised or we do not have up to date immunisation records**, they are to be **excluded** from school for two weeks after a case of an infectious disease is recorded.

You can obtain your child's immunisation history statement through Medicare or Medicare online, also your family doctor can print one for you.
