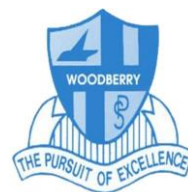

K-2 TRANSPORT EXCURSION / BIG DAY OUT

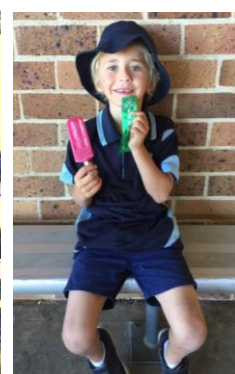

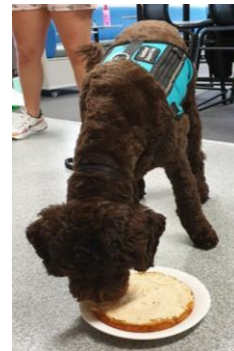
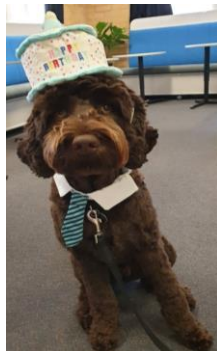
