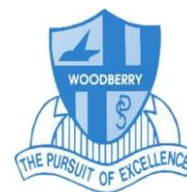

ZONE SWIMMING CARNIVAL

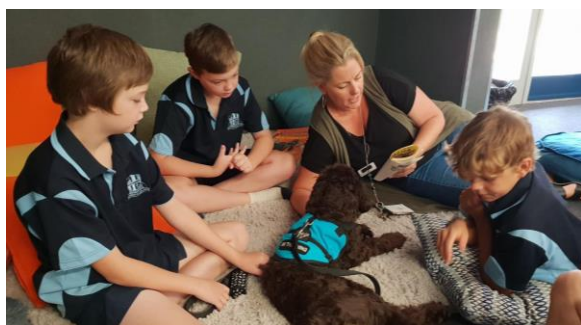
