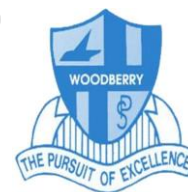

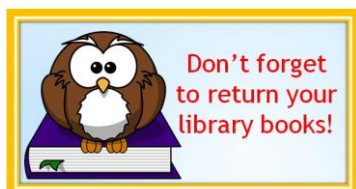
Our next Inclusive Communities meeting will be held on **TUESDAY 4th JUNE (week 6) 2.00-3.00pm** in the Place of Friends.
